<p><b>Bubbles Around the World</b></p> <p><i>Murgo, Brut Rose of Nerello Mascalese, Mt. Etna, Sicily 2013</i> 15 / 60 Bright red cherry and strawberry with tingling minerality and a crisp finish</p> <p><i>Can Petit, Macabeo blend, Cava, Spain NV</i> 9 / 36 Crisp with toasted brioche, pear, lemon and apple on the nose and palate.</p> <p><i>Norton, Brut Rose, Mendoza, Argentina NV</i> 12 / 48 Strawberry, red cherry and cherry blossom. Fleshy and fruity with a dry finish.</p> <p><i>Thevenet, Blanc de Blanc Chardonnay, Burgundy, FR</i> 16 / 64 Ripe Bartlett pear, Golden Delicious apple and hazelnut. Long, toasty, dry finish.</p>	<p><b>Pinot Lovers Unite</b></p> <p><i>Three different approaches to a traditional varietal</i></p> <p><i>Catalpa, Pinot Noir, Tupungato, Mendoza, Argentina 2015</i> 13 / 52 From a single vineyard. Showing red cherry and raspberry with hints of lavender and forest floor. Pleasantly bright acidity with a long, dry finish.</p> <p><i>Michel Sarrazin, Pinot Noir, Burgundy, FR 2014</i> 16 / 64 Tart red cherry and cranberry, dusty rose petal and a hint of forest floor. Elegant and delicate with hints of dried herbs and a long, luscious finish.</p> <p><i>Olema, Pinot Noir, Sonoma County, CA 2016</i> 13 / 52 Ripe and fruity with notes of baked cherry pie, vanilla, oats and hints of lavender and eucalyptus. Delicate body with a smooth and juicy finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 22</p>
<p><b>Aromatic Whites</b></p> <p><i>Taste how these varietals differ between warm and cool climates</i></p> <p><i>Hirschvergnügen, Grüner Veltliner, Kammern, Austria 2015</i> 11 / 44 Tart Granny Smith and Golden Delicious apple, with pear, lemon curd, lilies and beeswax. Wet stone mixed with a fleshy body, and a crisp, tingling finish.</p> <p><i>Avinyó Petillant, Muscat, Penedès, Spain 2016</i> 11 / 44 Fresh and fruity with Elderflower and honeysuckle, yellow peaches, Pink Lady apple and Jordan almonds. Light and crisp on the palate with a tingly finish.</p> <p><i>Karl Joh. Molitor, Riesling, Kabinett, Rheingau, Germany 2014</i> 10 / 40 Trocken, or dry style. Bartlett pear, McIntosh apple, grapefruit and a hint of wet stone. Fruity and round, with a crisp and flinty finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 16</p>	<p><b>Mountains to the Sea</b></p> <p><i>Cruise the elevations of Europe</i></p> <p><i>Ronchi, Nebbiolo, Barbaresco, Piemonte, Italy 2013</i> 18 / 72 Dark red cherry, dried purple plum and fig with hints of licorice, earth and tobacco. Medium to full with chewy fruit tannin and a long, lingering finish.</p> <p><i>Poliziano, Sangiovese, Toscano, Italy 2014</i> 10 / 40 Ripe red cherry and raspberry with a touch of red rose petal and licorice on the nose and palate. Bright and slightly chewy with a long, dry finish.</p> <p><i>Caravaglio, Corinto Nero, Salina, Italy 2015</i> 13 / 52 Ripe red cherries and blueberries, strawberry licorice, with fresh sage and fennel. Bright yet dry, with a salty, savory finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 21</p>
<p><b>Exotic Whites</b></p> <p><i>Crisp, esoteric and distinct</i></p> <p><i>Castaldi, Erbaluce, Piemonte, Italy 2014</i> 9 / 36 Overripe fruits of yellow apple, pineapple, and yellow nectarine. Full and juicy with a bright, dry, crisp and refreshing finish.</p> <p><i>Malvira, Arneis, Piemonte, Italy 2016</i> 12 / 48 Ripe fruit aromas of pineapple, Golden delicious apple with hints honeysuckle. Round and fleshy with defined herbs and minerality on the finish.</p> <p><i>Table de Sumar, Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain 2016</i> 10 / 40 Asian pear, yellow nectarine, meyer lemon with hints of apple and pear tree blossoms. Bright acidity and minerality with ripe, crisp finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 16</p>	<p><b>Spices and Berries</b></p> <p><i>Spice up your palate or give it a kick of fruit</i></p> <p><i>Saini Vineyards, Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma CA 2015</i> 14 / 56 Fruity notes of ripe red raspberry and grape jam with hints of clove, baking spice, and tobacco. Rich and juicy with a medium body and an elegant finish.</p> <p><i>Unti, Rosso del Campo, Barbera blend, Dry Creek Valley, CA 2015</i> 16 / 64 Blended with Sangiovese. Tart red cherry and plum, brush and wildflowers, with a touch of star anise. Rich in body with a long, velvety finish.</p> <p><i>Domaine de la Terre Rouge, Syrah, Sierra Foothills, CA 2012</i> 13 / 52 Blended with Mourvedre and Grenache. Purple fruits of boysenberry and cassis. Rich mouthfeel with hints of leather, game and spice. Long finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 23</p>
<p><b>Chardonnaysiens</b></p> <p><i>Old and New World versions of the classic Bourgogne white</i></p> <p><i>Chehalem, Chardonnay, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2015</i> 12 / 48 Fleshy palate with fruits of white peach, yellow nectarine and green apple. Lush and round with hints of chalk and wet stone, for a crisp, refreshing finish.</p> <p><i>Cuvée Delaye, Chardonnay, Saint-Véran, FR 2014</i> 13 / 52 Ripe Golden Delicious apple, Bartlett pear, lemon curd and kettle corn. Full and round palate with crisp minerality and a bright, pleasant finish.</p> <p><i>Nielson by Byron, Chardonnay, Santa Maria Valley, CA 2015</i> 16 / 64 Ripe Golden Delicious apple and Asian pear with notes of hazelnut, lemon curd and meringue. Round and weighty body with a crisp, bright finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 21</p>	<p><b>Bordeaux Blends</b></p> <p><i>Interpretations of the classic Bordeaux varietals from around the world</i></p> <p><i>Trivento, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 2014</i> 13 / 52 Dark purple plum, ripe raspberry, dusty rose, violet and damp forest floor. Full and rich with a dry, tannic finish.</p> <p><i>Hunt &amp; Harvest, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 2014</i> 16 / 64 Dark fruits of blackberry, boysenberry, dark plum, toasted oats, baking spice and cedar. Full bodied, with a pronounced, tannic finish.</p> <p><i>Il Bruciato, Cabernet Blend, Bolgheri, Tuscany, Italy 2015</i> 18 / 72 Ripe blackberry, dark cherry and boysenberry with cocoa powder, licorice and roasted coffee beans. Full and round tannin with a bright, yet smooth finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 24</p>
<p><b>Oak vs. Stainless</b></p> <p><i>Taste how aging styles can make a difference with these dry whites</i></p> <p><i>Deschamps, Sauvignon Blanc, Pouilly-Fumé, FR 2014</i> 15 / 60 Meyer lemon, white peach, Cantaloupe melon, salty minerals and wet stone. Bright and dry, and crisp with a long, savory finish.</p> <p><i>Scarbolo, Sauvignon Blanc, Friuli, Italy 2016</i> 12 / 48 Stainless. Bright and tropical with notes of guava, gooseberry, key lime and honeydew melon. Light and crisp with a dry, refreshing finish.</p> <p><i>Col Del Mondo, Trebbiano. Trebbiano d'Abbruzzo, Italy 2016</i> 10 / 40 Tart tree fruits of peach, green apple, tart green melon with accentuated grape seed tannins. Earth driven with a full body and a dry, savory finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 19</p>	<p><b>Uninhibited Reds</b></p> <p><i>Terroir driven varietals</i></p> <p><i>Happs, 'East of Alice', Nebbiolo blend, Margaret River, AU 2014</i> 13 / 52 Blended with Tinta Cao. Dried red plums, with raisins, cherry cola, fresh herbs and hints of wet forest floor. Smooth and round tannin with a long finish.</p> <p><i>Vera de Estenas, Bobal, Utiel-Requena, Spain 2016</i> 11 / 44 Red plum skins, tart, wild raspberry and blackberry with savory notes of star anise, and dried oregano. Medium bodied with a dry, lingering finish.</p> <p><i>Milenrama, Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain 2016</i> 9 / 36 Ripe red plum and raspberry, with hints of red roses, star anise, cherry cola and leaf tobacco. Soft fruit tannin on the palate, with a dry, bright finish.</p> <p><b>Tasting flight of above</b> 17</p>
