### Identity Crisis – Mixed 16

#### Woodford Bourbon | Bulleit Rye | Benromach 10 Year Scotch

Are you just getting started with whiskey and want to find out your preference: Bourbon, Rye or Scotch? The main difference is the grain used: corn vs. rye vs. barley. This flight will help you establish your whiskey identity.

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Ciccicoli or Farmhouse Cheddar

### Burden of Proof – Bourbon 16

#### Basil Hayden's (80 proof) | Buffalo Trace (90 proof) | Noah's Mill (114 proof)

Different techniques of distillation can result in different levels of alcohol content. The 'heat' is greater with the higher alcohol content bourbons, giving them a more robust flavor. Lighter proof bourbons tend to be smoother and more delicate.

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Boar Salami or Vacherousse

### Ryes to the Occasion – Rye 16

#### Templeton Small Batch | Willett Rare Release | High West Double Rye

The subtle difference in the taste of Ryes are based on the percentage rye (80%/92%/98% respectively), the location of the distillery and the distillation process (traditional pot distillation vs. modern distillation that is filtered more).

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Rabbit Pate or Ossau-Iraty

### Age Dilemma – Scotch 24

#### Caol Ila 10 Yr | Macallan 12 Yr | Linkwood 15 Yr

Aging has a big impact in flavor profile. Younger scotches tend to have more of a strong, firm palate, while older selections get smoother, adding layers of fragrance like cinnamon, clove, and peat.

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Rilletes or Cabricharme

### Hop Scotch – Single Malt Whiskey 32

#### Westland American | Nikka Taketsuru | Lagavulin 16 Year

It's not a real scotch unless it's made in Scotland. Or is it? Well, the Americans and Japanese take exception to that and here's their response. The water in each country ultimately makes the difference in flavor. See for yourself.

### Whistle Pig – Rye 42

#### 10 Year Straight | 12 Year Old World | 15 Year Straight

One rye is 100 proof and aged in bourbon barrels. Another is 86 proof and aged in 63% maderia, 30% sauterne and 7% port barrels. The third rye is 92 proof and aged in new Vermont oak grown on Whistle Pig's property. Can you tell which is which?

### High West – Mixed 16

#### American Prairie | Double Rye | Campfire

One master distiller playing with all 3 grains (corn, rye and barley). One is a bourbon, the other rye and the third, a blend of bourbon, scotch and rye. It takes a distiller from Utah to do something crazy like that.

### Compass Box – Scotch Blend 25

#### Hedonism | Great King Street | The Peat Monster

Compass Box is an American distiller that went over to Scotland using the highest American standards for whiskey making (don't tell that to the Scots). These 3 expressions of scotch range from smooth to smoky/peaty.

### Four Roses – Bourbon 29

#### Kentucky Straight | Small Batch | Single Barrel

Four Roses uses 10 distinct bourbon recipes and blends them together in their signature yellow label Kentucky Straight bourbon. The Small Batch uses 4 of the 10 recipes and is spicier and a bit richer. For the Limited Edition, the Master Distiller selects a few exceptional barrels. The bourbon is barrel strength and non-chill filtered so you get to savor it exactly as it comes out of the barrel.

### Who's Your Pappy? - Bourbon 90

#### Old Rip Van Winkle 10yr | Rip Van Winkle 12yr | Van Winkle Rye 15yr

After the 51% corn, most bourbons are rounded out with a mix of rye and barley. Not these bourbons. They use wheat instead of rye and are known as 'wheated' bourbons. The ages make the difference in taste. Most think the 12 year is the best. Try for yourself and find out who's your Pappy
