Hudson Baby Bourbon | Willet Rye | Benromach 10 Year Scotch

Are you just getting started with whiskey and want to find out your preference: Bourbon, Rye or Scotch? The main difference is the grain used: corn vs. rye vs. barley. This flight will help you establish your whiskey identity.

Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing: Ciccicoli or Farmhouse Cheddar

Burden of Proof – Bourbon 16

Basil Hayden's (80 proof) | Michter's (91 proof) | Noah's Mill (114 proof)

Different techniques of distillation can result in different levels of alcohol content. The 'heat' is greater with the higher alcohol content bourbons, giving them a more robust flavor. Lighter proof bourbons tend to be smoother and more delicate.

Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing: Boar Salami or Vacherousse

Ryes to the Occasion – Rye 16

Michter's Rye | Wright & Brown Rye | High West Double Rye

The subtle difference in the taste of Ryes are based on the percentage rye (70%/80%/98% respectively), the location of the distillery and the distillation process (traditional pot distillation vs. modern distillation that is filtered more).

Savage & Cooke Burning Chair | Wright & Brown | Seven Stills

Get a taste of the Bay Area with these local craft whiskeys. These whiskies are from Mare Island, Oakland and San Francisco Respectively. Distilled and Blended in House, you can taste the terroir and minerality of the bay area water.

Hop Scotch – Single Malt Whiskey 32

Westland American | Nikka Taketsuru | Lagavulin 16 Year

It's not a real scotch unless it's made in Scotland. Or is it? Well, the Americans and Japanese take exception to that and here's their response. The water in each country ultimately makes the difference in flavor. See for yourself.

Whistle Pig – Rye 42

10 Year Straight | 12 Year Old World | 15 Year Straight

One rye is 100 proof and aged in bourbon barrels. Another is 86 proof and aged in 63% madera, 30% sauterne and 7% port barrels. The third rye is 92 proof and aged in new Vermont oak grown on Whistle Pig's property. Can you tell which is which?

High West – Mixed 16

American Prairie | Double Rye | Campfire

One master distiller playing with all 3 grains (corn, rye and barley). One is a bourbon, the other rye and the third, a blend of bourbon, scotch and rye. It takes a distiller from Utah to do something crazy like that.

Teeling – Irish Whiskey 16

Small Batch | Single Malt | Single Grain

An Irish whiskey house playing with a traditional Irish whiskey (blend), a single grain whisky (corn& rye) and a single malt (barley). Disspell your notions that Irish whiskey is low quality but tasting through this flight and see just how complex and beautiful it can be.

Compass Box – Scotch Blend 25

Hedonism | Great King Street | The Peat Monster

Compass Box is an American distiller that went over to Scotland using the highest American standards for whiskey making (don't tell that to the Scots). These 3 expressions of scotch range from smooth to smoky/peaty.

Dalmore – Scotch Whiskey 50

Dalmore 12 | Dalmore 18yr | Dalmore King Alexander III

Each distillate spends some time in their signature 30yr old Gonzalez Byass Matusalem Oloroso Sherry casks before being transferred to other barrels. The 12yr and 18yr are then aged in Ex-Bourbon American. The King Alexander is then aged in Madeira, Ex-bourbon, Port, Cabernet Sauvignon and Marsala Barrels.

Where There's Smoke– Mixed Agave 16

El Pintor Tequila | Por Siempre Sotol | Fidencio

Perfect for the Beginner just exploring the wonderful world of agave. The main difference is the plant used and Mexican state distilled: blue agave(Jalisco), sotol (Chihuahua), espadin (Oaxaca).

Be Still My Heart – Rum 14

Diplomatico #1 Kettle | Diplomatico #2 Copper | Diplomatco Reserva

Different types of stills used can change the overall flavor of a distillate. This is due to different shapes and how alcohol vapors are consolidated. Kettle (Semi-continuous stills) collect the lighter, fruitier vapors, Copper Pot Stills collect the heavier more oily vapors. The Reserva is a blend of both stills.

Aging Gracefully – Tequila 35

Ayate Reposado | Forteleza Anejo | Don Fuliano Imperial

Aging has a big impact in flavor profile. Aged for 3, 4 and 6 years respectively. Younger tequilas have a fruitier, more mineral driven quality, whereas older tequilas are rounder, with more vanilla and cream notes.

Wild at Heart – Mezcal 33

Metiche | Domingo Michoacan | Bozal Cuishe

(Semiana, Michoacan, Cuishe) Most Mezcal on the Market is made from Espadin, a easy to grow and source domesticated agave. However, there are some producers that search high and low for wild agaves because of the beautiful and unusual notes it can impart on the distillate.
