Barley, Corn, Rye or Wheat these 4 grains make you used all over the world to make a variety of styles of whiskey, try this flight out to find out what you like.
- 4 Grains – Different Styles of Bourbon** 16
Eagle Rare (low rye) | Basil Hayden (high rye) | Larceny (wheated)
All four grains are used in making bourbon, however the ratio in which these grains are used creates a different flavor profile, try this flight to find your preferred style
- Ryes to the Occasion – Rye Whiskey** 18
Dad’s Hat (pre-prohibition) | Pikesville (post prohibition) | Woody Creek (current)
After cognac production fell off due to phyloxera Rye became the dominant spirit in the United states. It stayed that way until the 1970’s. Each of these Ryes give us a little looking glass into how rye has evolved over the years
- Seek Treatment – Different Barrel Treatments** 24
Dalmore 12yr | Angels Envy Bourbon | Old Charter Oak
One scotch in sherry barrels, one bourbon in port barrels, and a rye in vermouth barrels. All of these whiskies are unique due to the barrel treatment
- All the Single Barrels – Single Barrel Bourbons** 20
Henry Mckenna 10yr | Evan Williams single barrel | Blantons
Bourbon in its purest least complex form. These single barrels are distilled and then laid to rest for numerous years before they are pulled and bottled to show off the greatest product from each distillery

Stranger Stranger | The Spaniard | Flaming Heart

Barrel Aged & Sour Beers

Beachwood Brewing, Huntington Beach Ca - The Dream: 6.8% - \$23

ABV - Belgian-style sour ale fermented and aged in oak barrels with passion fruit, strawberries, guava, mango, and pineapples. Well balanced with a refreshing finish.

Cellador Brewing, North Hills California - Moshi Moshi: 6.5%ABV – \$18

Saison ale aged in 5 month old oak wine barrels with 150 pounds of Burgundy Plums from Andy's Orchard. Then into a 500L Sherry Puncheons, where it aged an additional 3 months before being bottle conditioned with orange blossom honey.

Ghost Town Brewing, Oakland California - Universal Jam: 7.4%ABV - \$22

This beer is a heavily fruited, oak-fermented wild ale with overdriven two-guitar harmonies of strawberries & rhubarb

Gigantic Brewing Company, Portland Oregon - Fancy Pants: 7.2%ABV - \$15

Hazelnut Chocolate Stout with notes of vanilla and hazelnuts grown in Portland. Smooth, rich and delightful

Mikkeller Brewing, Denmark, - Spontancherry Frederiksdal 2020: 7.2%ABV – \$25

Sour Ale brewed with Fredriksdal Cherries & Aged in Oak Barrels. The lambic-style beer has notes of cherries, almonds and sour fruit! The new 2020 edition!

Upright Brewing, Portland , OR Ives FOUR: 6.5%ABV – \$16

This release blended three well aged casks showing lemon and spice notes that serve as a counterpoint to the other floral and fruity flavors, notably rose and green grape. Moderate acidity lingers through a medium finish on this always evolving beer.
