Barley, Corn, Rye or Wheat these 4 grains make you used all over the world to make a variety of styles of whiskey, try this flight out to find out what you like.
- 4 Grains – Different Styles of Bourbon** 16
Eagle Rare (low rye) | Basil Hayden (high rye) | Larceny (wheated)
All four grains are used in making bourbon, however the ratio in which these grains are used creates a different flavor profile, try this flight to find your preferred style
- Ryes to the Occasion – Rye Whiskey** 18
Dad’s Hat (pre-prohibition) | Pikesville (post prohibition) | Woody Creek (current)
After cognac production fell off due to phylloxera Rye became the dominant spirit in the United states. It stayed that way until the 1970’s. Each of these Ryes give us a little looking glass into how rye has evolved over the years

Dalmore 12yr | Angels Envy Bourbon | Old Charter Oak
One scotch in sherry barrels, one bourbon in port barrels, and a rye in vermouth barrels. All of these whiskies are unique due to the barrel treatment

Henry Mckenna 10yr | Woody Creek Wheated | Blantons
Bourbon in its purest least complex form. These single barrels are distilled and then laid to rest for numerous years before they are pulled and bottled to show off the greatest product from each distillery

Barrel Aged & Sour Beers

GRIMM, Gathering, Brooklyn, NY 6% ABV – \$30

Barrel aged golden sour ale with apricots, nectarines, and plums.

Gathering represents fresh, local fruit picked at the peak of ripeness: apricots, plums, and nectarines from Bittner Singer Orchards in Appleton, NY. These fruits underwent a carbonic maceration and spontaneous auto fermentation before blending and secondary fermentation in some of the finest barrels of aged sour beer.

Beachwood Brewing / The Blendery, Huntington Beach Ca – Umebosi – Oak aged Sour with Plums and Sea Salt: 6.5% ABV - \$23

Lambic/Gose-inspired ale made with plums and Bamboo Jade Sea Salt. Bright stone fruit and their house funk dominate the aromatics followed by flavors of juicy plum and melon. There is a solid acidity all the way through, rounded out by the sea salt, and a finish reminiscent of sweet tarts.

Cellador Brewing, North Hills California – Le Con, Barrel Aged Wild Ale with Blenheim Apricots: 7.3% ABV – \$19

Belgian inspired aged hop base combined with tons of amazing Blenheim apricots from Cirone Farms. Aromatically this beer (especially this year's version!) is insane. Floral stone fruit wafts up and we assume it will blow your mind. This batch is slightly less sour than batches one & two with a medium acidity that is perfectly reminiscent of eating a fresh ripe apricot.

Urban Family Brewing, Seattle Washington – Solar Storm: 7% ABV - \$18

American style sour ale brewed with Raspberry & Lemon Zest. Aromas of fresh raspberry pair with bright lemon acidity in this well-balanced sour ale. Fruit forward with a refreshing finish.

Mikkeller Brewing, Denmark, - Spontancherry Frederiksdal 2020: 7.2%ABV – \$25

Sour Ale brewed with Fredriksdal Cherries & Aged in Oak Barrels. The lambic-style beer has notes of cherries, almonds and sour fruit! The new 2020 edition!

Upright Brewing, Portland , OR Ives FOUR: 6.5%ABV – \$16

This release blended three well aged casks showing lemon and spice notes that serve as a counterpoint to the other floral and fruity flavors, notably rose and green grape. Moderate acidity lingers through a medium finish on this always evolving beer.
